

Re: Approval to Import Amygdalin (Laetrile, Vitamin B17) 3gram vials

I refer to your correspondence received 12 October 2000 requesting permission to import Amygdalin (Laetrile, Vitamin B17) 3gram vials for the treatment of one of your patients under Category A of the Special Access Scheme (SAS).

Under the provisions of Regulation 5H, Item 12AA of Schedule 8 of the Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations, approval is hereby granted for the importation of 180 (one hundred and eighty) Amygdalin 3gram vials subject to the following conditions:

1. The Amygdalin vials are used only in accordance with your Category (A) notification dated 12/10/2000 under the SAS for the treatment of your patient LJ (DOB 8/1/1937).
2. This permit is for 180 (one hundred and eighty) vials each containing 3(three) grams Amygdalin (Laetrile, Vitamin B17) as a single consignment.
3. This permit is surrendered to Australian Customs at the time of importation.
4. All relevant State and Commonwealth laws are complied with.
5. The Commonwealth accepts no responsibility for any defects in the product related to manufacture, distribution or directions for use, including dosage or any other matter related to its use.
6. A record of distribution is kept and if requested by the Department or Australian Customs, these records must be supplied.
7. Any unused portion is appropriately disposed of in accordance with State and Commonwealth law.

This permit is valid for a period of 6 (six) months from the date of this letter.
